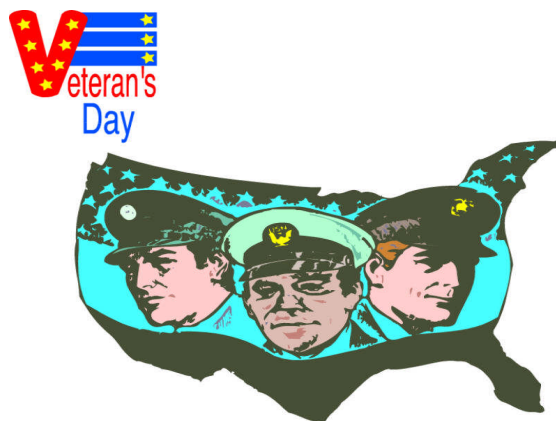
**Spiritual Pilgrimage

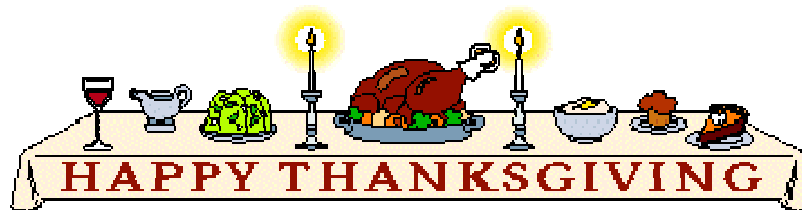
