Premeeting Notes of December 20, 2006 :

Prior to the start of the Business meeting, Bud Sexson, principal of St. John School, addressed the Council to ask us to help tutor students with reading and math for about 1 hour after school 3 days a week. Most of the students would be Middle school age although some may be younger depending on needs. Tutors are required to take Virtus training. This might be an opportunity for High School kids to assist and gain service hours toward their Confirmation.

The Council also heard from Mary Barnes, owner of Auctions by Mary. She discussed how to make a Fund Raising auction successful. Auctions are an excellent way to make money quickly. But for that to happen, we must make sure donations are not junk. Most people have at least 1 good item they can donate that could make money. Some stores will donate items or services too. Anything can be sold including candy bars and food. We should have at least 200 lots and the auction would last about 2-3 hours. Mary takes photos of the best items and puts out flyers and advertises in the Good News. They track all sales and can do pick ups of items. We can sell food and drinks. We can't charge admission (State law) and the crowd sets the minimum bid. They need about 2 weeks notice to advertise properly.
