- Fr. Festus would like the Council to replace the Braymer room carpet with tile.
- 09/29 Consignment Auction (set up on 09/28). We have to sign a rental contract and pay a deposit with the Dewey Fairgrounds. This will require lots of help with setup, kitchen, etc.

He asked for help with furnishing the Youth room with couches and chairs (either monetary or furniture donations). It was suggested that he have some of the kids involved to select furniture if it will be new. We want them to have what they want.

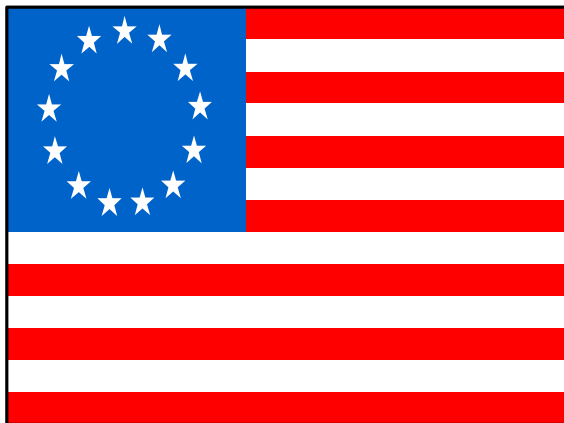
Up Coming Activities:
